WORK INCENTIVE DRAW

Starting January 2007 we are running an ongoing WORK INCENTIVE DRAW where staff have an opportunity to win a prize each month. Prizes have yet to be determined but they will be things like a weekend getaway to Harrison Hotsprings or a \$200 shopping certificate, etc.

We recognize that important work is provided for the company by all staff members, even those who only pick up one or two shifts each month. But this DRAW is intended to reward those staff who are working the most for Health Staffing International.

To be eligible, staff members must perform work for the company every week in that month and must not have missed or cancelled an accepted shift. From that group, each time a staff member works 4 shifts in the week one entry form is placed in the draw. The following month a draw will be made (usually at the staff luncheon) for the winner.

In addition, any staff member (regardless of how much they work) who brings in a new RN to work for the company will be eligible for the draw. An entry with their name will be placed in the month that the new RN completes their 4th shift. (This draw is in addition to the enriched referral bonus program for bringing in new RNs).
